

Four Interesting Questions

1) Have you found the limit to Grace?
or (from a practical standpoint)

What is YOUR limit to accepting the Grace God offers?

2) Are you looking for these limits so that you are continually (daily) expanding your personal limit to the maximum (if, in fact, there is a maximum)?

3) Why do so many professing Christians speak as if there is a limit to God's Grace?

=> "I don't have enough money to . . ."

=> "People won't cooperate so . . ."

=> "I don't have the time to . . ."

=> "When . . . then I will . . ."

=> "I wish I could, but . . ."

=> "I can't because . . ."

=> "If only . . ."

These, and similar statements, are clear denials of Grace. They say something about us OR something about Grace! Which would you guess is the limiting factor in what we accomplish?

Let's listen to ourselves and seek to be people of Grace and Faith because no one is greater than their faith in the Grace of God!

"I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power OF GOD . . ." To the extent we seek and find Grace, we will have the full power OF GOD to accomplish all He wants us to do!

We are saved by Grace – the gospel is the power of God for salvation for ALL who believe. Where we believe we have this power – where we don't believe we are on our own!

Oh, for the faith to believe for greater Grace!
